In accordance with 23 CFR 450.334, the Virginia Department of Transportation and the Winchester - Frederick Metropolitan Planning Organization (WinFred MPO) for the City of Winchester – Frederick County, Virginia urbanized area, hereby certify that the metropolitan transportation planning process is being carried out in accordance with all applicable requirements of:

- (1) 23 U.S.C. 134, 49 U.S.C. 5303, and 23 U.S.C. 450.334;
- (2) In nonattainment and maintenance areas, sections 174 and 176 (c) and (d) of the Clean Air Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. 7504, 7506 (c) and (d)) and 40 CFR part 93;
- (3) Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended (42 U.S.C. 2000d–1) and 49 CFR part 21;
- (4) 49 U.S.C. 5332, prohibiting discrimination on the basis of race, color, creed, national origin, sex, or age in employment or business opportunity;
- (5) Section 1101(b) of the SAFETEA– LU (Pub. L. 109–59) and 49 CFR part 26 regarding the involvement of disadvantaged business enterprises in USDOT funded projects;
- (6) 23 CFR part 230, regarding the implementation of an equal employment opportunity program on Federal and Federal-aid highway construction contracts;
- (7) The provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.) and 49 CFR parts 27, 37, and 38;
- (8) The Older Americans Act, as amended (42 U.S.C. 6101), prohibiting discrimination on the basis of age in programs or activities receiving Federal financial assistance;
- (9) Section 324 of title 23 U.S.C. regarding the prohibition of discrimination based on gender; and
- (10) Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (29 U.S.C. 794) and 49 CFR part 27 regarding discrimination against individuals with disabilities.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of the U.S. Department of Transportation, the Winchester – Frederick County Metropolitan Planning Organization (WinFred MPO), in cooperation with the State and affected Public Transportation Operators, is required to prepare a Transportation Improvement Program (TIP); and

WHEREAS, this TIP documents a cooperatively developed program of projects and planned federal obligations scheduled for implementation during a projected four year period; and


WHEREAS, this TIP is consistent with the MPO's adopted 2030 Long-Range Transportation Plan; and

WHEREAS, the MPO concurs with the strategy set forth by the Virginia Department of Transportation, Department of Rail and Public Transportation, Federal Highway Administration, and Federal Transit Administration to develop an initial version of a four year TIP in order to comply with federal SAFETEA-LU regulations; and

WHEREAS, this strategy includes working toward MPO approval of the project listing addendum that identifies federal obligations by project phase for the FY2009-2010 years, and completion of appropriate MPO planning and public participation activities for administrative modification or amendment of the FY 2006-2008 TIP to incorporate this FY2009-2010 project listing addendum.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the WinFred MPO does hereby concur with this strategy to incorporate the FY 2009-2010 project listing addendum to the MPO's FY 2006-2008 TIP.
